Policies

Program The summer program operates for 10 weeks, with a different theme and educational program each week. You may enroll for the whole summer or individual weeks.

Age Groups Children who have completed Kindergarten through 6th Grade are eligible. Children are placed in groups based on their age and grade with exceptions made when appropriate.

School Holidays Camp will be closed on Monday, July 5th. Tuition will remain the same during this week.

Absences Please notify our office at (949) 854-7611 by 9 am if your child will be absent. No refunds or make-up days can be made in case of absence or illness.

Lunch Snacks are provided. Hot lunch option may be available. (See summer camp lunch menu) If bringing a lunch, it **must** be in a zip-lock bag with name and date clearly marked.

Backpacks Your child is **required** to bring a backpack daily containing a change of clothing, a towel, sandals, and disposable camera (optional).

Dress Your child is **required** to wear his/her Turtle Rock T-Shirt every day. You will receive one free T-Shirt per child with registration. Extra T-Shirts may be purchased for \$12 each. Children are required to wear tennis shoes and socks daily. All clothing and items brought to school **must** be clearly marked with child's name. We are not responsible for lost items.

Water Activity On swim, water play, or beach days: Sandals may be brought to school in child's backpack. On these days, please send your child to school with sunscreen already applied at home and wearing his/her bathing suit and rash guard. Sunscreen and rash guards are **required**. We also suggest your child wear a baseball caps or other hat with brim. An additional bottle of sunscreen should be given to a camp staff member.

Parent Meeting All parents **must** attend a Parent Orientation Meeting on June 16th from 5:00 - 6:30 pm for vital camp information. Children are welcome to attend!

Enrollment To register, complete the attached registration form and mail it with your fee of \$30 per family, and a deposit of \$150 per child. The deposit will be applied to your last weeks tuition. Registration fee and deposit are both non-refundable.

Tuition Policy Payments are due on the **first day** of each month, in advance, for the weeks of enrollment. A \$15 late fee applies after the 5th, and an additional \$15 late fee after the 10th. On-site Visitors and Field Trips are included in the tuition. Optional excursions will be an additional fee. Spaces are limited. **There are no refunds or schedule changes, regardless of reason, after June 25th.** All activities and excursions are subject to change.

Discounts 5 day programs with a minimum sign-up of 5 weeks will receive a 10% discount if ½ tuition is paid by June 1st. After June 1st, 5 day programs with a sign-up of 5 weeks will receive a 5% discount. No enrollment deposit is required when pre-paying in full.

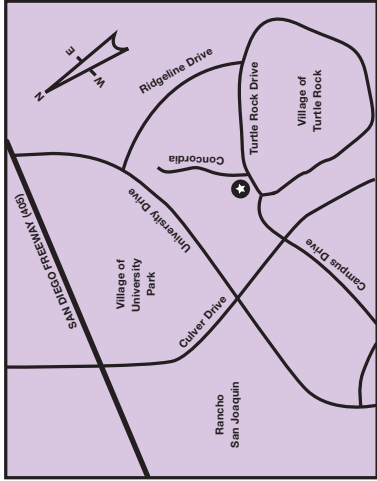
